PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The Bangsamoro Youth Leaders Program-Leadership Communities (BYLP-LeadCom) is a year-long initiative of the Office of the Regional Governor –Autonomous Region of Muslim Mindanao, Ayala Foundation, Inc. and Eisenhower Fellows Association of the Philippines. The first batch of BYLP graduates in 2015 are 28 young leaders from Basilan.

Starting with a four-week learning circuit, participants meet inspiring individuals and organizations, visit institutions and join educational tours in key cities all over the country.

Now expanded to cover the whole ARMM, BYLP-LeadCom aims to empower young leaders from Basilan, Lanao del Sur, Maguindanao, Sulu and Tawi-Tawi through on-site immersion for them to undertake relevant programs that transform communities in the areas of health, education, livelihood, peace and governance.

PROGRAM OBJECTIVES

- Engage youth leaders to help them become more productive citizens
- Provide learning opportunities to develop youth leaders as servant leaders.
- Promote a better understanding of the Bangsamoto – culture, tradition, and practices.
- Provide opportunities for youth leaders to implement projects supporting ARMM HELPS.

PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY

To apply for the BYLP-LeadCom, the applicant must:

1. Be a Filipino citizen, 18-30 years of age at the time of the Program August 29, 2016.
2. Be a bona fide resident of ARMM.
3. Must not have been subjected to any disciplinary case nor have been charged and/or convicted in a civil or criminal case.
4. Be a recognized, active, and effective youth leader or officer in:
 - Recognized school organizations (e.g. student government, co-curricular, extra-curricular, cause oriented, religious organizations)
 - Community organizations (e.g. Local Government units, religious-based Organizations, Socio-Civic Groups, Volunteer Organizations, etc.)
5. Be a model of integrity, discipline, excellence
6. Must have sincere desire to serve and a passion to bring about positive change in society

PROGRAM APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

The applicant must submit all of the following documents:

1. A fully completed application form.
Applicants can also download a copy of the application forms from the ARMM Website and AFI Website.
2. FOR CURRENTLY ENROLLED STUDENTS ONLY: Certification from your college dean or registrar that will signify the status of your enrollment for academic year 2016 – 2017.
3. Barangay Clearance or Mayor's Clearance (signifying that the applicant is a resident of the respective barangay/municipality/city of ARMM.)
4. Police Clearance or NBI Clearance
5. Certifications supporting leadership experience, awards received and community involvements.
6. Personal essay.

All application documents submitted will become the property of the BYLP – LeadCom Secretariat and will NOT be returned to the applicants.
